



coyote lake-harvey bear open all year

Camp alongside beautiful Coyote Lake where you can boat, fish and picnic at our scenic 3-mile long reservoir while enjoying more than33 miles of surrounding hiking, biking and equestrian trails that wind through the Mt. Hamilton range. Lakeview Campground provides 2 restrooms and showers, fresh tap water, firepit barbecues, 73 campsites each with a paved slip, table and food locker. Nearby attractions include Gilroy Gardens Family Theme Park and Hecker Pass wineries. 10840 Coyote Lake Road, Gilroy, 95020



joseph d. grant open all year

For hikers, bikers, fishermen, equestrians and star gazers, Joseph D. Grant ranch is the ideal spot to set up camp. Located in the rolling east foothills of Santa Clara Valley, this 9,522 acre park has plenty of open space offering 37 family campsites with restrooms and hot shower facilities. Group picnic and youth camping areas are available by reservation. There are 8 equestrian sites available for rigs with horse trailers. mt. madonna open all year

Experience the splendor and majesty of the redwoods. This park offers a 20-mile trail system for hikers and equestrians winding through groves of the world's oldest species of trees. Mt. Madonna has 4 separate campgrounds with 117 drive-in campsites with restrooms and shower facilities, and 29 partial hook-up RV sites. Yurts are available in 3 sizes offering bunk beds with mattresses, futons and a wrap-around deck. Sanborn RV open all year, hike-in camps available March-October

Wake up in the grandeur of the Santa Cruz Mountains when you spend a night in the magical forests of Sanborn County Park. This park has over 18 miles of trails that show its geological features as well as the lush flora of the area. Sanborn Park has 33 hike-in camp sites 1 group site and 13 RV campsites with partial hook-up and a dump station. An American Youth Hostel is located in the park. Fishing is available nearby and a short drive will take you to Saratoga Village, Hakone Gardens, Villa Montalvo, and numerous wineries. 16055 Sanborn Road, Saratoga, 95070



UVAS CANYON open all year

Let the sound of the waterfalls lull you to sleep after you set up camp at Uvas Canyon County Park. By day hike any one of the 7 miles of hiking trails including the Waterfall Loop and view some of the park's many waterfalls.
