Minimum Qualifications

- ✓ Must be at least 21 years of age
- ✓ Possession of a valid California Drivers license
- ✓ Two (2) year degree from an accredited college
- ✓ Must not have been convicted of a felony or equivalent offense (Government Code Section 1029)
- ✓ Must pass a background investigation & Psychiatric evaluation (Government Code Section 1031)
- ✓ The ability to swim one hundred (100) yards within five (5) minutes (verification) from a certified swim instructor issued within the last twelve (12) months
- ✓ Ability to pass standard POST physical agility exam
