Descriptions and analysis in this section are based on information documented in the Archaeological Assessment and information provided by the California Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC), Northwest Information Center (NWIC), National Register of Historic Places (NR), California Register of Historical Resources (CR), California Historical Landmarks (CHL) list, California Points of Historical Interest (CPHI) list, California State Historic Resources Inventory (HRI), the results of Native American outreach, and a pedestrian survey of the site conducted by Dudek.
