



# Santa Teresa County Park

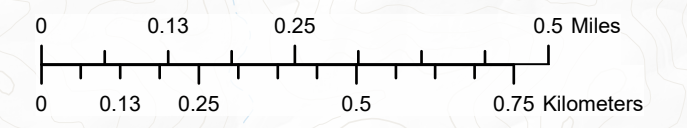
Santa Teresa County Park is open year-round from 8 a.m. until sunset. Vehicle entry fees are collected year-round. Fees are required to reserve the Pueblo Group Picnic Area. For green fees and other information regarding the golf club, call (408) 225-2650. The ranger station for Santa Teresa County Park is located at Hellyer County Park (408) 225-0225.

In an emergency, call 911.

- Dogs/Pets:** Allowed in all areas of the park on a 6 foot or less leash, except for the Bernal-Gulnac Joice Historical Area.
- Fires:** Permitted in designated barbeque pits only. No fires on open ground. No wood gathering.
- Weapons:** Firearms, air guns, archery equipment and paintball guns are prohibited
- Alcohol:** Permitted in picnic areas. All alcohol laws strictly enforced
- Wildlife:** Collecting of plant specimens or animals is not permitted.

**Be Considerate:**
